

### **Shrine Hospitals Update**

## SHC - CINCINNATI RELOCATING

The Shrine Hospital for Children located in Cincinnati, often referred to as Cincinnati Burns Hospital, will be relocating to Dayton Children's Hospital. The Burnet Avenue location in Cincinnati will remain open and in full operation until the transition is completed late in 2020.

Over the past year, rumors had the hospital "closing," but these have always been incorrect. In March of 2019 it was announced that SHC was working with Dayton Children's to relocate inside their recently vacated intensive care unit. Since that announcement, it has taken until early in January 2020 to get all the approvals and signatures. Now, it is official. This is an exciting time for our hospital sys-

The right-sizing of space allows the hospital to be good stewards of our donations while continuing to treat all size burns and plastic and reconstructive

surgery. There has been a steady decline in the severity and number of pediatric burns in the United States, especially those requiring a long hospital stay. This is all good. The hospital has added new specialties in "plastics" or cosmetic surgeries, among others, to improve children's lives

Things will continue as normal. This relocation allows SHC to remain in the area and will continue to change children's lives and save children's lives. Nothing else matters. We have been caring for children for 50 years and plan to continue for another 50 years!

The hospital will be renamed, due to the location change, and should be operating by late 2020. Until then, the hospital remains in full operation at Cincinnati location, serving patients and accepting new one. Continue to support our hospi-




