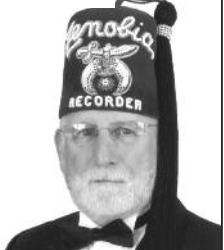

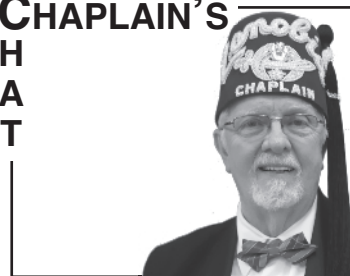
Tickets previously sold are still good for the future show based on day and performance. The program books are

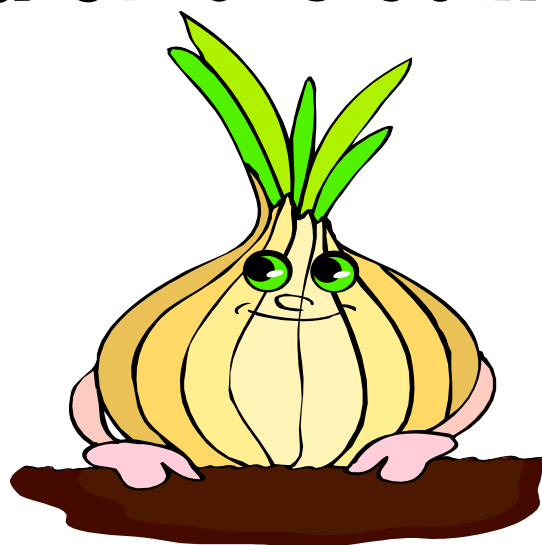

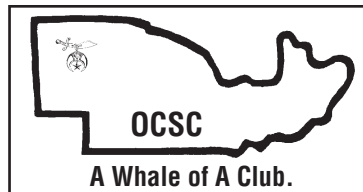
