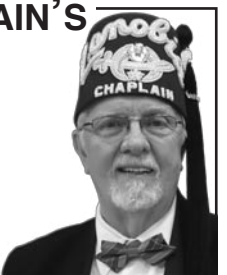
While the Circus is more

## YOUR OHIO SHRINE HOSPITAL

**Your Shrine Hospital in Ohio is doing well!** It is fully operational and receiving patients every day. Just like always, your Ohio Shrine Hospital is still the best place for pediatric burn care. Encourage patients, no matter the level of burns, to come to Shriners for outstanding burn care.

Did you know that the Ohio Shrine Hospital is now one-hour closer to Toledo? Yes, during the months of January and February, what was known as the "Cincinnati Burn Hospital" was relocated inside Dayton Children's Main

Hospital. The name has also been changed to Shriners Children's Ohio. It is the same great service, same wonderful people and same family friendly experience, now offered inside a warm receptive location in Dayton.

Our first patient was served at the new location on Monday, February 22, 2021. This is now our location for all our Ohio Shrine medical services. Besides pediatric burns, we also serve cleft lip and palate, cranial facial deformities, along with many common "plastic surgeries" including birthmark reduction or

visual improvements which improve the quality of life, many not covered by insurance. This is our only Shrine Hospital in Ohio.

A formal ribbon cutting ceremony was to be held on February 27. It could be watched via Facebook.

Make plans to visit your Ohio Shrine Hospital that treats burns and many other non-orthopedic pediatric needs. You are invited to attend an open house which will be in August.

Your Ohio Shrine Hospital is operating fully and needs you to refer patients.
