October.

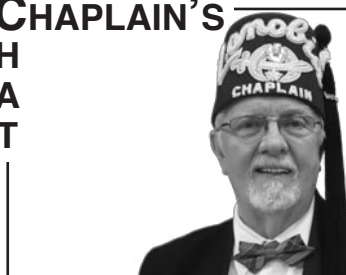
How can your group help? See if your unit would like to handle some small part of the circus for a performance or a day. You can organize your group of workers and take pride in playing a supportive role with the circus.
