ZENOBIA ELECTION DECEMBER 9, 2021

Shriners International Bylaws
Election Regulations, §325.11

§325.1 l(a) **Electioneering.** A candidate for an elected office in a Shrine temple may print, publish and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a resume consisting of his educational background, his vocational history and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email or other devices, by a unit, club, noble, or group of nobles, suggesting, recommending, opposing, or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited.

§325.1 l(b) **Expenditures Prohibited.** The expenditure of money for gifts, favors or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited.

§325.1 l(c) **Violation.** For any violation of (a) or (b), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending noble, and he may declare the election of the officers void and order a new election.

§325.1 l(d) **Notice.** At least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election, the temple Recorder shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing this section.

The 2022 Zenobia Shrine Circus is scheduled and will happen during March 17-20.

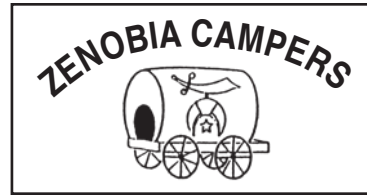

Dramatic Cast



The Dramatic Cast was founded in 1953 when Ill. Sir Joe Arnold asked Noble Harry Nehring to start a ritualistic unit to do the first section of the ceremonial. Noble Nehring was a member of Barton Smith Lodge and a noted ritualist. Noble Nehring was able to assemble a group of skilled ritualists from Nobles who participated in degree work in Blue Lodge and Scottish Rite. This was a big change for Zenobia, as the Divan did the first section prior

to this change.

Shortly after the unit was formed, costumes were purchased. The cast has used these costumes from the 1950's to the recent spring ceremonial in May of this year. To say these costumes had seen better days is an understatement. They were in poor shape when this writer joined the cast in the 1980's. One of our cast members had a "wardrobe malfunction" and lost his costume pant as he was doing his part. The drycleaner the cast used declined to clean them as he thought the costumes might fall apart.

Ill. Sir Isaac Demarest and Zenobia's Divan authorized the purchase of new costumes. Sev-

eral firms were contacted for quotes. New London Regalia Manufacturing Co. was chosen to provide the new costumes. The costumes are the property of Zenobia Shrine and will continue to be used for many years.

The November 13 Ceremonial went very well – everyone knew their part and the "new look" was great. Due to unforeseen circumstances (work and medical) several members of the cast were not able to participate. Fortunately willing Nobles stepped up to fill in: Steve Hessler, Membership Chairman; Ty Stout, Chief Rabban; Doug McGee, HPP, and Kevin Ridgeway, OG and Cast Divan Representative. 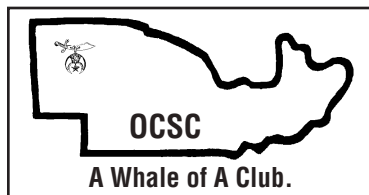

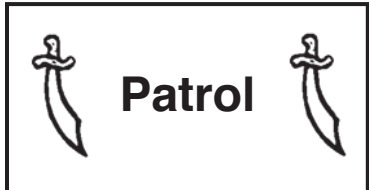
