

#### **GIVING TO THE FRATERNITY**

Shriners,

As we close out 2023 and begin the year anew, I am thankful for the brothers and Shriners who have come before us. Several of our brothers and Shriners who have passed the last couple years provided for the Shrine and their lodges with a portion of their wealth, allowing us to maintain our buildings, our programs, and our activities. I can't begin to name all of those who left their mark for us, however many of you know those who came before. My hope is that all of us seek to be someone who leaves their mark and continues our legacy.

As we begin 2024 I hope that we can emulate our brothers generosity with a similar attitude and consider donating now or later to the Shrine and lodges to continue our legacy and maintain our fraternity.

If you are interested in learning more about how to give effectively there are several ways that you might contribute to the fraternity. Because our organizations are 501c10s, we are not tax deductible for donations but the fraternity does not pay income taxes. That tax status allows the Shrine or Lodge to cash in investments that are appreciated (increased in value) without having to pay Capital Gains taxes or Ordinary Income taxes.

Another way to contribute to the Fraternity is through beneficiary designations for assets like IRA's, 401k's, Annuities, Life Insurance and even a Will. Because of the tax status of our Fraternity we will not pay a tax on the gifts in that manner. When investments like Annuities, IRA's and 401K's are left for loved ones they will pay a tax on receiving them while the Shrine and lodge will not. These are often one of the best ways to donate without affecting the outcome for anyone since the taxes owed by our loved ones won't be owed by the Fraternity.

If any one is interested in learning more or discussing their situation I know we can always do an education at the Shrine or even talk privately about your situation. Consider continuing the legacy of our Fraternity and your place in it.







The Jeepster unit had another successful year going to most of the 43 scheduled parades throughout northwest Ohio and southern Michigan. The Jeepsters receive donations for most of the parades and these proceeds go directly to the Shriner's Hospitals for Children.

At the Zenobia stated meeting held December 14, on behalf of the Jeepsters, Director Ron Smith gave a \$1,000 donation to each of the hospital trustees: Dennis Gabel, Ohio Dayton; Keith Tuttle, Chicago, and Charles Murphy, Erie, Pennsylvania, for a total of \$3,000.

None of the donated proceeds goes to the individual members who own their antique Jeepster automobile. The Jeepsters are maintained at the expense of the owner and no reimbursement is given for gas mileage. During the parade season, from May through December each year, each Jeepster drives approximately 2,000 miles.

The Zenobia Jeepsters are probably the most recognized unit for the Shriners in northwest Ohio. The Jeepsters were only made three years, from 1948-1950, by Willis Overland in Toledo.
