

Winry was burned several years ago after accidentally running through the ashes of a fire pit that were thought to be extinguished. Ivan, a tall, physically fit teenager from Ukraine hoped to become a professional arm wrestler and weight lifter. That changed after a 2022 missile strike where Ivan’s legs and left arm had severe injuries including broken bones. The incident was captured by Associated Press and included in an Oscar-winning documentary “20 Days in Mariupol.”

Ivan had an operation in occupied Ukraine and was treated until the hospital ran out of medicine. A children’s charity led by a physician at Shriners Children’s offered care in the U.S. After orthopedic care and skin grafts at a Georgia hospital, Ivan was transferred to Shriners Children’s inpatient rehabilitation. Ivan improved with Shriners Children’s multidisciplinary approach to rehabilitation.
