



## Shriners Children's Chicago researcher presents how weight-bearing CT scans may guide treatment options

Most children are born with flat feet and grow out of the condition by age 6. But in some cases, flatfoot persists and causes pain that requires medical treatment, especially in kids with orthopedic conditions such as cerebral palsy.

At the 2025 Shriners Children's State of Science Conference, Karen Kruger, Ph.D., from the Motion Analysis Center at Shriners Children's Chicago, presented how weight-bearing CT, a 3D imaging technique, may help guide treatment options. Her study, among the first to examine weight-bearing CT on pediatric patients, will compare the new technology with traditional 2D X-rays currently used in clinical care.




