

# Abagail and Hannah Clark, MS, CPO, Honored with National Award from the American Orthotic and Prosthetic Association

Patient ambassador Abagail and Hannah Clark, MS, CPO, of Shriners Children's Erie have been recognized with a prestigious award from the American Orthotic and Prosthetic Association (AOPA) at their National Assembly.

The award was based on the prompt: "The symbiotic relationship between manufacturers, clinicians and patients—leading to successful fits and outcomes—is often overlooked unless it involves a high-profile case." Abagail's journey exemplifies this powerful partnership in action. Her

physician, Stephen Mendelson, MD, identified the need for a unique approach to managing her severe double major curve, which included a high thoracic curve. He turned to the Pediatric Orthotic and Prosthetic Services (POPS) team with a request for a brace that was both low profile and highly effective.

In collaboration with Spinal Technology, the Shriners Children's Erie POPS team custom-designed an anterior open Boston-3D brace specifically for Abagail. The outcome was remarkable, her spinal curve was reduced by over 50% in-brace, a significant clinical achievement.


Hannah submitted Abagail's case to AOPA's national governing body and within days, they were notified of their win. As a result, Abagail and Hannah have been invited to present their story in front of more than 500 attendees at AOPA's National Assembly this September in Orlando, Florida.




