My apology, but this month's article is a rehash of my October article. I feel this is very important information and, because of the placement in last month's Hadji, I want to make every effort to ensure that people see it.

Since last January, I have been asked how much a Life Membership to Zenobia would cost. (This is like an Endowed Membership in Blue Lodge.)

As I understand it, according to Shriners International there are two levels: Life Membership (LM), Total Life Membership (TLM).

Life Membership (LM) pays your Temple (Zenobia's) annual dues but does not include the hospital or International per capita. It is important to note that a Life membership is not transferable to other temples.

•If member is over the age

of 65 years – the cost is 10 years times the temple dues amount.

(10 x \$115 = \$1,150).

•If member is under the age of 65 years – it is 20 years times the temple dues

amount

 $(20 \times $115 = $2,300)$

For the Total Life Member (TLM), the Noble is technically purchasing three different types of life purchases.

1. Per capita dues life purchase = \$1,500.00

- 2. Hospital Levy life purchase = \$150.00
- 3. LM Purchase (Temple "only") life purchase = \$ X.xx times "X" years pending on the Noble's age

So, depending on your age, a TLM will cost either \$2,800 (65 and older) or \$3,950 (under 65).

In the long run, this is beneficial for both the Noble and Zenobia.

I do hope this information is beneficial to you.





UNIQUE LOCAL INNOVATION IN SCOLIOSIS CARE EARNS NATIONAL RECOGNITION



Shriners Children's Erie patient Abagail and her orthotist, Hannah Clark, MS, CPO, traveled to Orlando, Florida, where they received prestigious national recognition from the American Orthotic and Prosthetic Association (AOPA) at its National Assembly. On September 4, the pair served as keynote speakers, sharing their story with an audience of more than 500 attendees. Abagail later reflected that the experience was nerve-wracking at first, but she felt more confident once Clark joined her on stage to help share the story.

For the past four years, Clark has cared for Abagail, working closely with the Shriners Children's Erie Pediatric Orthotic and Prosthetic Services (POPS) team and Spinal Technology to design a custom anterior open Boston-3D brace specifically for her needs. Abagail's physician, Stephen Mendelson, MD, recognized that managing her severe double major curve, which included a high thoracic curve, would require a unique approach. He re-

quested a brace that was both low profile and highly effective. Unlike traditional braces, the Boston-3D applies corrective pressure on the outer side of the curve while cutting out corresponding areas on the inner side, allowing the spine to shift in the desired direction. With Abagail's dedication to wearing the brace and the customized design, her scoliosis curve has been reduced by more than 50%, an outcome rarely achieved.

Coincidentally, just days before Clark learned of AOPA's award prompt, Abagail had jokingly remarked that she deserved recognition for her commitment to wearing her brace. Clark knew she was the perfect nominee. Abagail's journey perfectly illustrated the theme: the symbiotic relationship between manufacturers, clinicians and patients—leading to successful fits and outcomes—is often overlooked unless it involves a high-profile case.

Within days, Clark and Abagail learned they had been chosen. Soon after, they were invited to Orlando to share their journey on the national stage. The trip also marked another milestone for Abagail and her family, it was their first time flying on an airplane, adding to the excitement and memories of this once in-a-lifetime experience. Abagail's mother, Shameka, described the moment of seeing her daughter speak on stage as overwhelming and full circle, emphasizing that the moment truly belonged to Abagail.

Their story demonstrates the power of collaboration between patients, providers and industry partners working together to achieve life-changing results. By celebrating Abagail's perseverance and Clark's expertise, this national recognition not only highlights the impact of personalized scoliosis care but also underscores the role of Shriners Children's Erie in advancing pediatric specialty care locally and across the country.


