JESSEE SPILLMAN APPOINTED SECOND CEREMONIAL MASTER

Introducing Zenobia's New Second Ceremonial Master – Sir Knight Jesse Spillman.

Born in Astoria, Oregon, on December 11, 1983, Jesse Spillman spent his earliest days in the rugged beauty of Alaska, moving there only a few months after his birth. Raised first in the bush and later in Anchorage, he attended Bartlett High School, where he was a standout athlete—competing in hockey, wrestling, track and football. His teams earned notable achievements, including the 2003 State Football Championship, and Jesse himself was recognized as a 2002–2003 All-State Linebacker.

After graduation, Jesse enlisted in the U.S. Army as an Infantryman. He deployed to Iraq in 2006 and 2007 in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom I and II. Upon returning stateside, he transitioned into recruiting and later completed his military career as a Staff Sergeant Mortuary Affairs Specialist, using humor to describe the role as “a fancy way of saying dealing with the dead.”

In 2012, Jesse moved his family to Ohio to assist his father-in-law following a dia-

gnosis of stage-four brain and lung cancer. He married his wife, Jessie, a native of Edon, in 2013. The two met while Jesse was stationed in Alaska, and he often jokes that Jessie had to “import” her husband because she's related to everyone in Edon. Together they have four children – McKenzie (19), Michael (19), Mylee (13) and Maggie (8). Today, McKenzie is a high-school graduate, Michael proudly serves in the U.S. Navy, and Mylee and Maggie attend school in Fremont, Indiana, where they stay active in a variety of activities.

Since relocating to Ohio, Jesse has built a successful career in real estate, serving northwest Ohio through Jesse Spillman Realty.

Jesse began his Masonic journey in Edon Lodge No. 474, where he was raised in February 2014 and later served as Master of the Lodge in 2018, 2021 and 2022. His dedication to the craft extends broadly across the York and Scottish Rites. He currently serves as:

A long-time member of the Shriners Children's medical community, Dr. Pahys brings not only exceptional clinical expertise, but also a deeply personal connection to the field of orthopedic care.

Dr. Pahys' journey into medicine was shaped by his own experiences as a patient. Born and raised in Cleveland, Ohio, he was diagnosed with scoliosis as a teenager, wore a back brace and later underwent spine surgery to remove a tumor from his lower back. With the help of expert care, he recovered quickly, going on to play college basketball at Johns Hopkins University just months after his surgery. His medical journey inspired him to pursue a career in orthopedics, completing medical school and an orthopedic surgery residency

in Philadelphia.

During his residency, Dr. Pahys trained at Shriners Children's Philadelphia, where he was moved by the compassionate, high-quality care provided to children with complex conditions. Motivated by that experience, he pursued a fellowship in complex spinal surgery and officially joined the Shriners Children's Philadelphia spine team in 2010. In 2015, he expanded his commitment to the Shriners Children's mission by joining the team at Shriners Children's Erie, where he continues to provide specialized spine care to pediatric patients.

"I am deeply honored to serve as Chief of Staff," said Dr. Pahys. "I am thrilled to have the opportunity to play a role in helping to build on the already strong 100-plus year foundation of Shriners Children's Erie."

Dr. Pahys is known for his clinical excellence, strong rapport with patients and families and collaborative leadership style. In his new role as Chief of Staff, he will support the Erie team in advancing patient care, innovation and clinical excellence.

It was a busy 2025 for the unit and 2026 looks to be as busy or busier. The unit transported approximately 60 patients in 2025. We only had one trip cancelled, due to inclement weather in Chicago.

We have had to adapt to the patient's needs. In the past the two drivers would meet the patient and their representative at one of our designated pick-up points. In specific cases we are now picking up the patient at their home, due to circumstances where they are unable to get to one of our pick-up locations along the route to the hospital. In these instances, we have driven east to pick up a patient going west to Chicago, only to drive past where we started the day; driven north or south before eventually heading west or east to the hospital. It's all part of what we do to ensure the child gets to their appointment safely and on time.

The families we transport are wonderful. Over time you may get to know a few families well. The impact you, as a Roadrunner, can have on a child and family makes being a Roadrunner very rewarding in a personal way.
